Welcome to the NRCC Comic-Con's costume contest! We are excited to see your costume! Here's an overview of the different divisions:

- 1. Craftsmanship: This is for people who made modified or made some part of the costume, whether it's a garment or a cool prop, if you've made or modified something, we want to see it.
 - a. We want to get to know your costume better, so you will have a 5 minute pre-judging appointment. We just want to chat with you about your costume, the effort you've put into it, and how you've made or modified it. We also want to admire your costume too, so we may ask to check out your awesome costume up close.
- 2. Performance: Here's where you get a chance to showcase your costume to everyone. It doesn't matter whether you made it or not; our audience wants to see you!
 - a. In this division, you will be judged based on how you present your character on stage, from moving and posing like your character, how you use the stage, and how you show off your awesome costume. You will be on stage for ~1 minute, so feel free to do a skit or do a walk-on, a series of 3-5 poses, each pose for 5-7 second each so we can get great photos of you!
 - b. Costumes competing in craftsmanship also will get to do a performance too, to show off your costume to all!

Here's the procedure:

- 1. Please sign up here, so we can get a sense of who's coming. If for some reason you cannot, there will be sign-ups on-site.
 - a. Craftsmanship sign-ups: 10am-12:30
 - b. Performance sign-ups: 10am-1:30
- 2. If you're craftsmanship, we will email you your appointment time. We're happy to chat with you at that time.
- 3. Regardless, please be back in front of the stage at 1:30 so you can line up to be a part of the contest and be on stage.
- 4. Show off your costume on stage! It's from 2-3pm!
- 5. We'll announce winners at the end of the contest!
