my accounts setup: SIS email Canvas NRCC Help Desk 540-674-3600 extension 4400	<p>It is very important for students to access their NRCC My Accounts prior to classes beginning. A single log-in provides access to the Student Information System (SIS), VCCS student email, Canvas, and Zoom. A username and password is required.</p> <p>If you do not know this information, follow these simple instructions: Go to www.nr.edu and click the My Accounts link in the top right corner. Next, click the Forgot Username and/or Password link(s) and follow the instructions provided. If you are unable to retrieve your username and/or password, please contact the NRCC Helpdesk by calling 540-674-3600 ext. 4400, or call the Advising Center at 540-674-3609 (advisors are staffing the line. If your call goes to voice mail, please leave a message with your name and phone number and an advisor will call you back).</p> <p>Your VCCS student email account should be checked regularly. Emails about financial aid reminders, important dates, and other helpful information are sent to this account.</p>	<input type="checkbox"/>
pay tuition Business Office 540-674-3605	<p>Tuition bills will be mailed once you've registered for classes and tuition payments are due by 5:00 p.m. on Wednesday, August 12. If you are awarded financial aid, all items required for your financial aid must be finalized by August 12.</p> <p>Students who have not paid their tuition or finalized their financial aid by this date will be dropped from their classes. (If a student is dropped from classes he or she can re-register; however, tuition payment will be due that day.)</p>	<input type="checkbox"/>
financial aid Financial Aid Office 540-674-3615	<p>If you applied for financial aid using the FAFSA (Free Application for Federal Student Aid) you will receive notification from the financial aid office through your Message Center located in the Student Center of SIS regarding the status of your financial aid. Any items listed in your "To Do" list must be completed before your eligibility can be determined. If you have not applied for financial aid, it's not too late. Please complete your FAFSA (www.studentaid.gov) as soon as possible. Financial aid funds are available on a first-come, first-served basis so it is important not to delay applying.</p>	<input type="checkbox"/>
orientation Advising Center 540-674-3609	<p>If you are new to college, you are required to complete new student orientation to learn essential information designed to help you succeed at NRCC. New Student Orientation is offered online and will open on Monday, August 3 and needs to be completed by Friday, August 21. New students will receive emails, mailers and phone calls from their student services advisor to provide information and guidance for how to participate.
