

Using Your TEAS Score in the Admissions Process for the RN Nursing Program

Prospective Nursing Students:

Your TEAS score will be available electronically to Kimberly Johnston, who will note that you have completed this requirement in the application process. TEAS scores will be used, along with curricular GPA and number of curricular courses completed, to make admission decisions. You can determine your total TEAS score by adding the **National Percentile Rank** in each of the three categories. The maximum possible is 300. During the 2010 selection year, we are **NOT** using the **TEAS Math**. Do not include Math in your total.

Example:

	<u>Percentile Rank</u>
	National
TEAS: Reading: (40 Items)	56
TEAS: Science- (30 Items)	83
TEAS: English- (55 Items)	66
Add the three categories for total:	205 (<i>out of possible 300</i>)

While your TEAS score is not the only determinate for admission (GPA and completion of non-nursing courses in the curriculum also count), a high score will have a significant positive impact. A student's score is compared to others applying to NRCC's nursing program, so there is no pass or fail score; however you can see that the higher that score, the better.
