- 2.0 cumulative GPA for former LPN students applying for readmission
- TEAS
- Attend required meeting (after March 31 if folder is complete)

The TEAS scores will be used to evaluate academic skills. TEAS testing dates and other pertinent information will be mailed out as it becomes available. Your folder must be complete by March 31 of the selection year in order for you to attend a required information session. You will be notified online of any requirement changes. You will need to complete the following admission requirements to be eligible for the general information session:

- \_\_\_\_\_ completion of all necessary developmental courses (*if identified by the placement tests*)
- \_\_\_\_\_ cumulative 2.0 GPA (*for students reapplying for LPN program*)
- \_\_\_\_\_ TEAS scores
- \_\_\_\_\_ attend general information session
