Taubman Museum, Roanoke: Saturday, April 1st leaving from the Dublin campus at noon and returning before 6. Student pays \$3 admission and the club pays the other \$3. See the permanent collection, and current American Impressionism exhibit with Romare Bearden and a local jewelry artist's work.
