Thank you for your interest in the NRCC Associate Degree Nursing (RN) program at New River Community College! Please note that admission to the A.D.N. program is competitive entry consisting of TEAS scores, G.P.A.'s, and non-nursing classes. Information session dates and other pertinent information will be available at a later date online at www.nr.edu/nursing. You MUST attend an information meeting and take the TEAS at NRCC before you are eligible for review. If using a previous year TEAS scores, please contact the Nursing Admission Advisor. Incomplete folders will not be reviewed. Any requirement changes will be noted online. You will need to complete the following requirements to be eligible by March 15th of the year you are applying for. (This date is subject to change):

- ___ application to NRCC
- ___ *official high school transcript or satisfactory completion of a GED
- ___ *official college transcript(s)
- ___ one unit of high school biology (including lab) or equivalent completed prior to March 15th
- ___ one unit of high school chemistry or equivalent completed prior to March 15th
- ___ completion of ENG 111 before Summer 2018 – English Composition I
- ___ completion of BIO 141 before Summer 2018 – Human Anatomy & Physiology I
- ___ completion of PSY 230 before Summer 2018 – Developmental Psychology
- ___ completion of SDV 100 before Summer 2018 – College Success Skills
- ___ completion of the NRCC placement test for math (you must pass the first five modules of the VPT placement test) or college level math course taken during the past year – March to March
- ___ GPA in high school of 2.5 or curricular GPA of 2.5 in 12 or more college credits
- ___ TEAS, expected to be 45th percentile (National Percentile Rank) or above. If testing at an off campus site, an official copy is required by March 15th.
- ___ attend general information session
- ___ Preference is given to applicants living in NRCC's service region

These requirements must be met by the deadline or you will need to apply to the following selection year. It is your responsibility to ensure that your folder is complete and your mailing address and phone number are correct on the Student Information System (PeopleSoft).
