



How to View Instructor Feedback on an Assignment

1. Go into the course and choose “Grades.”




2. Look at the assignment that you have submitted. If you see this image to the right of the assignment, you have instructor feedback. Click on the image to view comments from your instructor.




3. To view the rest of the instructor's feedback, click on the assignment.
