What to Bring:

The FAFSA questions ask for information about you (your name, date of birth, address, etc.) and about your financial situation. Depending on your circumstances (for instance, whether you are a U.S. citizen or what tax form you used), you might need the following information or documents as you fill out the application:

- 1. Your Social Security number (it's important that you enter it correctly on the FAFSA form)
- 2. Your parents' Social Security numbers if you are a dependent student
- 3. Your driver's license number if you have one
- 4. Your Alien Registration number if you are not a U.S. citizen
- 5. 2016 Federal tax information or tax returns including IRS W-2 information, for you (and your spouse, if you are married), and for your parents if you are a dependent student:
 - a. IRS 1040, 1040A, 1040EZ
 - b. Foreign tax return and/or
 - c. Tax return for Puerto Rico, Guam, American Samoa, the U.S. Virgin Islands, the Marshall Islands, the Federated States of Micronesia, or Palau
- 6. Records of your untaxed income, such as child support received, interest income, and veterans non-education benefits, for you, and for your parents if you are a dependent student
- 7. Information on cash; savings and checking account balances; investments, including stocks and bonds and real estate but not including the home in which you live; and business and farm assets for you, and for your parents if you are a dependent student
